

Revision/Editing Checklists--Fairy Tale

Revision: I made sure to...

- Write a beginning that introduces my main character, other important characters, and the problem in my story.
- Write a middle that shows how the main character tries unsuccessfully 3 times to solve the problem.
- Write an ending that shows how the problem is finally resolved.
- Use transition words to connect my ideas (e.g., *first, then, next, finally, because, before, during, after, when, in the beginning, at the end, the next day*, etc.).
- Use vivid adjective to describe the characters and places in my story.
- Write my ideas clearly, so my reader can understand what I wrote.

Editing: I made sure to...

- Use an uppercase letter at the start of each sentence.
- Capitalize people and place names.
- Use a period or other punctuation to end each sentence.
- Reread to check the spelling of each word.
- Fix the spelling of misspelled words.
